Subject: Summer Camp '09 Bursaries Program

This is to inform all members of the Canadian JKF Wado Kai that a new program will be put in place to assist full-time students who would like to attend our camp: *Summer Camp '09 Bursaries*.

The goal of this program is to give full-time students, who may not be able to attend due to the expense, some financial assistance. The organizing committee is pleased to announce that the Canadian ZenKuRen Wado Karate Association (CZWKA) will underwrite this program, which will award:

Two Partial Bursaries

These bursaries will cover the camp fee as well as one ticket to the evening *Women in Karate '09* dinner/conference.

Two Full Bursaries

These bursaries will cover the camp fee, one ticket to the evening *Women in Karate '09* dinner/conference and three nights (Friday through Sunday) accommodation at the UQAM Residences.

Applying

Applicants are evaluated on financial need first and foremost. If you are a full-time student, and would like to apply, then please send us the following:

- A letter addressed to the Summer Camp '09 Organizing Committee, telling us why you would like to attend this event. Please attach a photocopy of your student identity card.
- A letter of endorsement from your club instructor, which describes why we should consider your application for one of these bursaries.
- We are accepting applications from full-time students aged 16 to 25 years old.
- If a student who is less than 16 years old would like to apply, we will need a guarantee that an adult (parent, guardian, chaperone) will be traveling

with them and will be present for the duration of the camp. This person's name should be mentioned in the letter that the applicant sends us.

The deadline to apply for a bursary is **April 8, 2009**. We will consider all applications and try and match a bursary to an appropriate applicant, if at all possible. Each student who is awarded a bursary will still be responsible for their meals and transportation (and accommodation in the case of a partial bursary), and will be required to attend all Summer Camp '09 training sessions and the dinner/conference.

It is our hope that this new and innovative program will help to foster a spirit of openness and a desire to learn in our younger members, who are the future instructors and administrators of our association and of karate in Canada.
